She ruled the others with a quack, quack, quack!

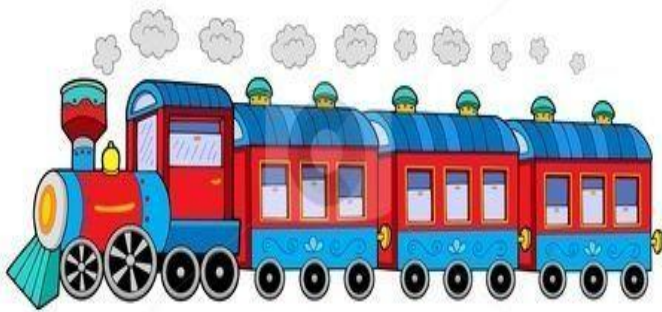


8. RAINBOW RAINBOW

Let’s go and play.”

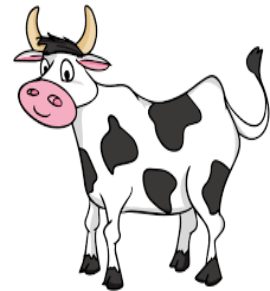
Kitty cat, kitty cat,
